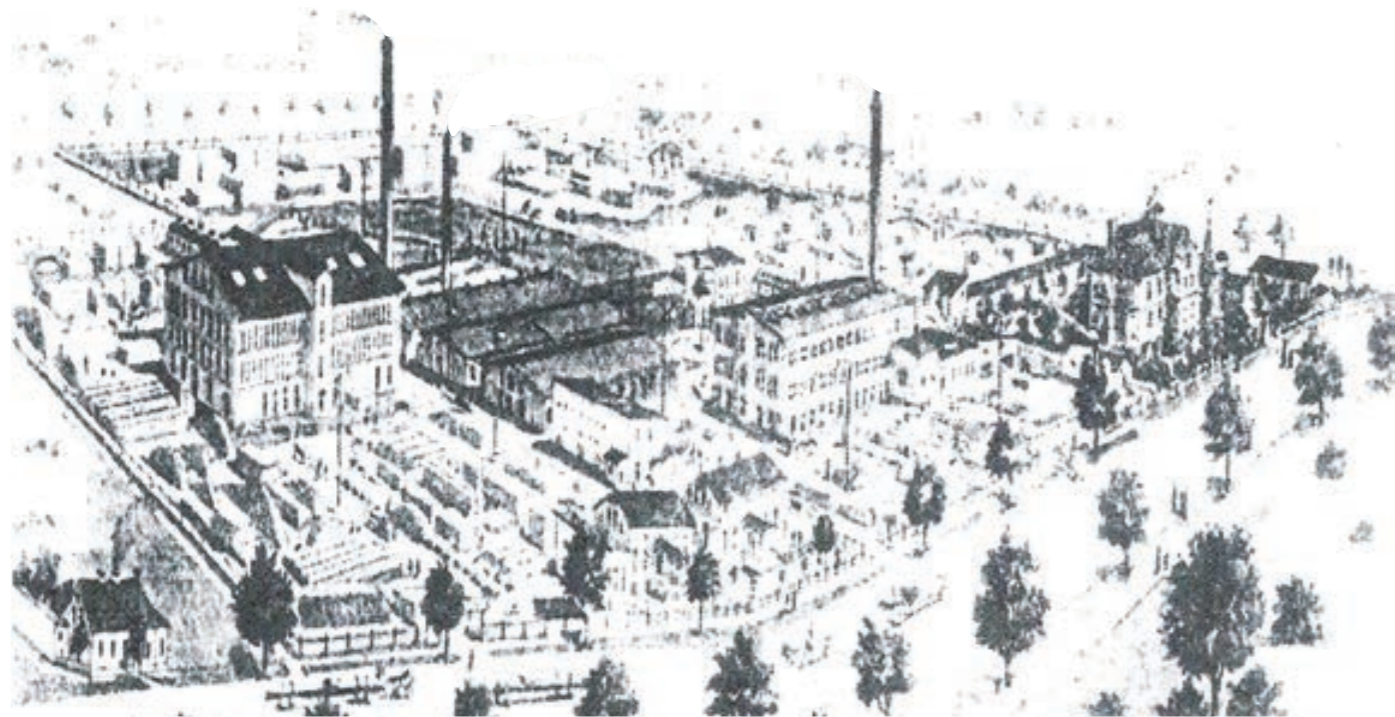

The secret of the kiln and the manner of its manual operation have been passed down from generation to generation.

## *Traditional standards*

Quality control occurs at every step in the process, from our own raw materials through to the finished product. With loading and unloading of the kiln by hand, the tiles are visually checked before and after firing. We maintain our high standards of quality through rigorous and thorough quality control procedures set at each stage of production, making sure any tile or fitting that does not meet the required market demands, is removed and recycled.

Our tiles are produced from own high quality clay reserves, combined with natural environmentally friendly materials, and fired in a coal fired Hoffmann kiln. Firing in this way bestows the tiles with their unique character and shades, which is virtually impossible to recreate with gas fired kilns. Once fired, tiles are unloaded, sorted and palletted by hand. This is our final stage of quality assessment, as the human eye is the finest instrument to assess the subtleties of the finished products.

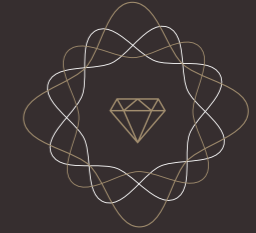

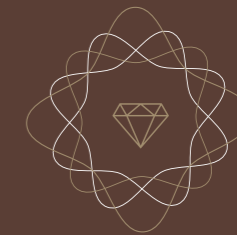

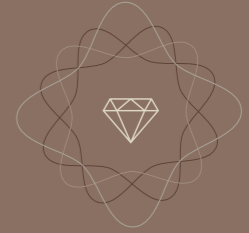

## Manor Weathered. South England

Sometimes it's worthwhile to focus on a unique roof that will make your house the first eye-catching object in the area. Sometimes, however, it is better to create a picturesque background for beautiful yet small elements that will come to the forefront and make the house look special. This is the dilemma that we faced in this project.

We could choose two routes. The first one was a roof tile standing in sharp contrast to the façade of the building. The second option was the Weathered roof tile that would connect the walls and roof in terms of tone and let the green shutters play the leading role. This solution turned out perfect. The house became really stylish and distinctive.

Standard does not necessarily have to be a symbol of repeatability of style. For us, standard is associated with repeatability of quality. more punch in the context of the entire area where it is situated. ## Manor Red. South London

The Manor roof tile works well in all types of projects. Our portfolio includes buildings of various purposes, with very diverse forms and styles. The building shown on the left has a larger roof area and the roof is one of the most important elements of the entire house. Also the façade has partly been covered with roof tiles. Here the investor decided to apply the

Manor Red roof tile which – used over the large area – softly but considerably brightens the entire structure, giving it a touch of lightness. The classic style is complemented by white window frames. Regardless of the dimensions of the building, each type of the Traditional roof tile may be perfectly added to the structure of the house and to its surroundings.



## Guarantee

Quality control occurs at every step in the process, from our own raw materials through to the finished product.


All batches of tiles are tested within the factory to BS EN 538 Flexural strength, BS EN 539-1 Impermeability and BS EN 539-2 Frost Resistance. Further samples of tiles are independently tested and certified in the UK by Lucideon, approved by UKAS and British Standards Institute. Our tiles were also tested by German Keramik Institut GmbH. All of our tiles come with a 30 year guarantee.
